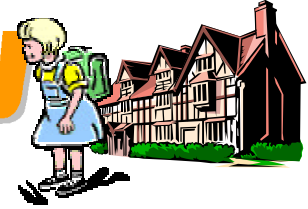




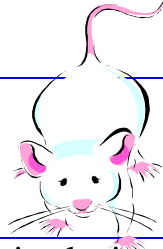
# host family
